

3 Internships during the covid-19 pandemic

The course Internship has the following learning objectives:

- The student demonstrates that (s)he is capable of applying your knowledge/insights and skills in the specialised area of the Master(track) to practical situations;
- The student can recognise and reflect on his or her own performance of the legal/functional role, and relationship with personal standards and values
- The student can recognise and reflect on ethical dilemmas during the internship;
- The student is able to identify and reflect on the main social and psychological, organisational, financial and/or any other factors that play a role in the opportunity to act in accordance with professional ethics.

It is important that these learning objectives can also be achieved while working remotely. Trainees should therefore be enabled to attend online meetings, to have direct (online) contact with clients and colleagues and to attend (online) social activities. Indicate in a few sentences whether, and if so how, this is possible at the internship placement.

4 Internship provider statement

The intern will be supervised by a legal professional for the entire duration of the internship. At the end of the internship, the internship supervisor will complete the evaluation form, on which the supervisor will assess the intern's performance and indicate the overall satisfaction with the intern's performance.

In relation to this internship, the intern will attend the track 'Legal Ethics and Professional Identity for Legal Professionals in Practice' at the UvA. The lectures may be taught while the intern is undertaking the internship. You are kindly requested to allow the intern to attend this track.
